



Patient Financial Responsibility

Insurance coverage is not a guarantee of payment.

We will bill your insurance as a courtesy if you present your insurance card(s) at the time of your appointment.

Any patient responsibility (deductibles, co-pay, co-insurance) must be paid at the time of service.

If we do not receive payment from your insurance company within 60 days from the billed date, the balance will become your responsibility.

You will receive a statement for any remaining balance after all applicable insurance(s) have been billed. That balance will be due in full at that time or you are welcome to contact our billing office to set up payment arrangements.

We accept cash, check, VISA and MasterCard credit cards. Payment in full at the time of service is required in the following circumstances:

You are a self pay patient (payment arrangements can be set up if you are not able to pay in full at time of service).

You have not brought your insurance card(s) with you.

You have not met your deductible.
